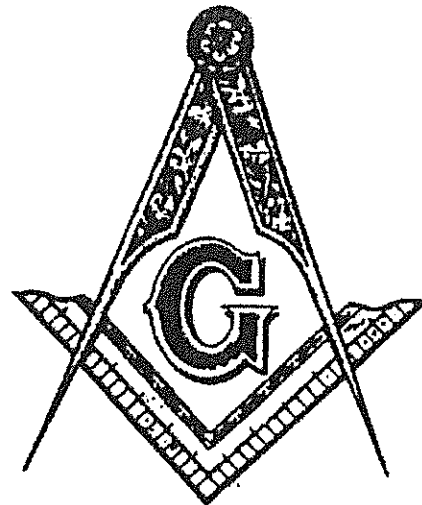
Turnerettes meeting minutes for April 2, 2013

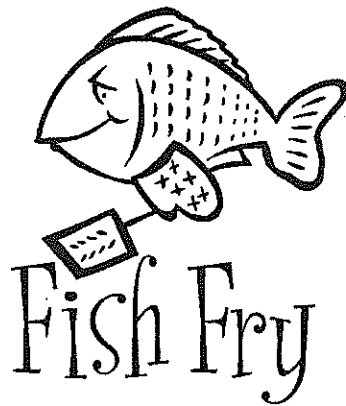
