must look at installing a gate and curbing the driveway so that no access can be gained by driving through the front lawn. We also need to repair the lighting so our parking lot and entrances are well illuminated. Bro. Rick Schleppe recently installed an LED bulb on the front porch. This bulb provides 100 watts of light for a fraction of the electricity of an incandescent bulb. As a result this light will burn continuously and last for many years. Thanks to Bro. Rick our front door will be well lit and secure.

Another important part of a secure lodge is a strong membership. As of this writing there are about 30 of you who have not yet paid your dues and will be receiving second notices. A Mason is a Mason for life! We would hate to lose anyone for non-payment of dues. If you have not paid your dues yet please contact either our Secretary W.B.
